Next FHMD Meeting -

The next Falcon Highlands Metropolitan District Board Meeting is scheduled to meet at the Falcon Fire Station #3 on 14 August 2017 at 5:30pm. Residents and property owners are invited.

Water Conservation -

Water Conservation is still in effect. Even numbered addresses can water Tuesday, Thursday and Sunday. Odd numbered addresses can water Monday, Wednesday and Saturday. No watering on Friday is permitted. Also watering should be done between the hours of 6PM and 10AM.

Concrete Work -

The District contracted All Trades Concrete to install sidewalk on Antelope Meadows Circle where no sidewalk exists. They will also install sidewalk on Seely Circle this will be a welcome improvement for the school bus riders. Work is expected to be complete within the next 60 days or so.

November 2017 Election -

The Falcon Highlands Metropolitan District will hold a mail ballot election this November for water infrastructure funding. This funding, in conjunction with refinancing the District's existing bonds, will allow for the construction of <u>much</u> needed water infrastructure with <u>no tax increase</u>. Please keep an eye out for additional information on the water infrastructure project and the upcoming election. A Community Meeting at the Falcon Fire Station #3 is scheduled for August 26, 2017 at 11:00 a.m. to discuss this infrastructure project and the November Election.
